

Information and Regulations

A dog which has earned its C.D. title in the U.S. is not eligible for entry in the Novice A Class and a dog which has earned its C.D.X. title in the U.S. is not eligible for the Open A Class. Such dogs must be entered in the B Class respectively.

Veteran's Class: for dogs with an obedience title and are 7 years old on the day of the trial. Dogs entered in Veteran's class may also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.

Rally Novice A – Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs that have earned titles or are not the owner may enter in the **Novice B** class. All exercises are judged on leash and must enter and leave ring on leash.

Rally Novice B – Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Advanced A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Advanced B - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Entry fees will not be refunded should a dog be absent, sick, lame or excused by a Veterinarian, Judge or Trial Superintendent.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Refunds will be made when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season after entry has been submitted if a Veterinarian's Certificate is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infraction of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. The Trial Superintendent will be in complete charge of these trials which will be governed by C.K.C. Rules. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

***Exhibitors will receive identification cards and a judging schedule as soon as possible after entries close, by **Mail, Fax, or E-Mail**. Exhibitors must identify the form in which they wish I.D. and judging schedule to be sent. Place **E-Mail address** or **Fax #** in the box provided on the entry form if you wish to have them sent this way. Should this box be not filled, the I.D. and Judging schedule will be mailed. Arm Band Numbers can be picked up at the Trial Secretary table if E-Mail or Fax is used.

If, because of riot, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

When Judges assignments have reached 7 hours, entries will close automatically even if official closing date has not arrived. The above is based on the formula of 8 Novice dogs/hour, 7 Open dogs/hour and 6 Utility dogs/hour (CKC Rule 4.3.3 & 4.3.5)
 CKC Rule 4.1.6: When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries **may** be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of his/her position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing date, it **may** be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. **Entry fees will be refunded within ten days following the trial for those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.**

COMBINATION AWARD



Sponsored by: Thunder Bay Cocker Spaniel Club & Lakehead Kennel Club

The purpose of this award is to encourage dog show participants to promote their dogs as both conformation and obedience animals. The award will be presented on **Saturday, July 28, 2007**, after the conclusion of Best in Show judging. It will be awarded to the dog which has competed in both conformation and obedience on that day, and which has received the highest number of points. Trial #2 and Saturday's Show will be used for this award.

POINTS WILL BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS

Obedience

Highest score obtained in an obedience class, with the provision that the dog must receive at least a qualifying score. **Maximum 200 points.**

Conformation

Highest level attained based on the following (only the highest level of points will apply; if dog places in Group, then its lower breed points will not be counted). **Maximum of 100 points**

Best in Show	100 points	
Group 1 st	75 points	BOB or variety 25 points
Group 2 nd	60 points	BOS or BOW 15 points
Group 3 rd	50 points	Winners 10 points
Group 4 th	40 points	Any other breed placing..... 5 points

In the event of a tie score, a Run-off will determine the winner.

Don't forget, let us know if your entered in Conformation on your entry!

Foreign Exhibitors

Event Registration Number (ERN)

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first trial entered. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to obtain an ERN number within thirty days of the the first trial at a CKC event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

Performance Event Numbers (PEN)

A performance event number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate to the breed.
