3. Must have been a conformation exhibitor for at least 7 years.
4. Must have shown outside the Northern Ontario & Manitoba area in the last 5 years and have attended at least one of their breed's National Specialties.
5. Committee meets once or twice a year...and occasionally is required to make an emergency decision via email.

She got her Therapy Dog International certification 2 weeks later, then on to Duluth, where she got a

Sadly her last two entries had to be pulled as she succumbed 8 hours after I brought her home from being spayed July 15. She died by my side during the early a.m. of July 16th.
