TRAVEL PERMIT INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

- 1 A travel permit is required for all tournament and exhibition games played outside of the league's scheduled regular season, and playoff games.
- 2 Exhibition games require a travel permit. On-ice officials may be arranged privately or through TBMHA office. Officials must hold current certification for level of play.
- 3 Submit or fax the completed application to TBMHA offices as early as possible.
- 4 Deadline for applications is 28 days prior to date of departure.
- 5 Individual clubs are responsible for game changes. Early submission at start of season prior to issue of full game schedule avoids potential conflicts.
- 6 TBMHA office forwards form to Hockey Northwestern Ontario (HNO) for actual permit.
- 7 Game changes are official after TBMHA approval.
- 8 Pick up completed Travel Permit at HNO, 216 Red River Road, Ste. 100, no sooner than one week before event.
- 9 HNO charges organizations a \$10 non-refundable fee for a Travel Permit.
- 10 Notify HNO office (623.1542) and TBMHA if cancelling permit. Game changes remain in effect.
- 11 When arranging game change(s) in Part 1, swap games in same division, keeping one team common if possible.
- 12 Standard travel permission is Thursday to Monday inclusive. Modify if required.
- 13 Upon return to Thunder Bay, submit copies of game sheets with incident reports to TBMHA office before playing your next scheduled game. If in doubt, do not play any possibly suspended players until after consulting Grievance Chair.
- 14 Playing a suspended player will forfeit any points earned in game(s) that player participated in.
- 15 Travel permits are required for all tournaments except those hosted by TBMHA. Local tournaments such as Norwest and Nipigon require travel permits.
- 16 If in doubt, ask questions at TBMHA office. Don't assume, check details out.
