

***CHANGE IN SCHEDULED CNTC GAME***  
and  
***the Stratification for the Open Game***

For those of you who follow the schedule of events on the Bulletin Boards or on the Web you will ***a notice a change*** in the CNTC game scheduled for Nov 10<sup>th</sup> game.

***The CNTC game originally schedule for Nov 10<sup>th</sup> has been changed to Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>.***

***Reason:*** The Knights of Columbus have an annual Remembrance Day commitment with the Royal Canadian Legion so on Nov. 10<sup>th</sup> and we will not have the use of the “big” room.

On Tuesday November the 10<sup>th</sup> we will play in the small room [the one usually used on Wed. & Thurs. afternoons] and the small room where we keep our supplies. On that evening we ***will not*** hold a 199'er section. The game that night will be stratified as follows:

***A Strat:*** - Two members holding 200 Master Points or more playing together [no handicap]

***B Strat:*** - One member holding 200 Master Points or more playing with a member holding less than 200 Master Points [half board handicap]

***C Strat:*** - Two members holding less than 200 Master Points playing together. [one board handicap]

***Note to 199'ers:*** Check out the results on the Web for September 28<sup>th</sup> [the last time we did this] - the 199'ers ***placed well*** in both sections playing either together or with a “master”.

Come out on Nov 10<sup>th</sup> and prove it wasn't a “fluke”.
